Proceeds from this event will support the Meals on Wheels program of Mineral County. Jennings Randolph Lake is a reservoir of 952 acres located on the North Branch Potomac River in Mineral County, WV and Garrett County, Maryland. The lake was constructed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Construction of the lake was completed in 1981. The highlight of this event is that runners and walkers will travel over the dam and spillway, normally closed to public travel.

- When: Saturday, May 10, 2014
- Where: Begins and ends at the top of Howell Run Picnic area. There will be a downhill start and then cross the dam and spillway (normally closed to public travel) and then reverse direction with a moderate uphill climb to the finish.
- Registration: \$20 if received by May 1, 2014. \$25 late registration after May 1. Race day registration will be held from 8:30 AM until 9:15 AM at the Howell Run Picnic area. \$15 registration fee for those 18 and under. Maximum family registration \$50. There will be no refunds.
