Lodging is available at the University Place Dormitory at Potomac State College. University Place has three types of rooms. Quad suites are two separate rooms for a total of four individuals sharing one bathroom. Each of the rooms contain two twin size beds. The second room type will be a Private Double Suite. These contain two smaller rooms with twin beds and a private bathroom. The Private Double Suites are very limited. ## University Place Lodging Options

This is the primary lodging location for most Olympians.

Lodging at the college includes a pillow, blanket, one fitted sheet, one top sheet, a pillowcase, two towels and a wash cloth. Beds are made prior to guest arrival. Rooms and baths will be serviced on Wednesday and Thursday. All common areas are maintained daily. Guests will receive their room key between 10:00 AM and 12:00 Noon on Tuesday, June 12th. Although a continental breakfast is not available, the college grill (located in the dorm) will be open to purchase breakfast and/or coffee. Also, located in the University Place, is a fitness center, theater, lounges, laundry room and more, all of which will be available to our seniors. Traditionally, lounges and the Heritage room are used each evening by participants to play a variety of board and card games and also to socialize.

The beds at the University Place are somewhat high. There will be a few step stools available to use during the Olympics.

Bingo will be held in the University Place Theater. Our Scrabble and poker competitions will be held in the dorm's conference rooms. Lodging at the campus will allow the participants to walk to and from their rooms when they are not competing.
